#### OUR GOALS

The mission of ReThink Disposable is to stop trash before it starts. The program's vision is to see reduction and reuse automatically woven into how we dine, so that trash in our streets and water are eliminated, and people and the planet are protected.








# WHEN A SMALL RESTAURANT SWITCHES TO REUSE FOR DINE-IN:

- Eliminate 115,000 disposable packaging items, every year
- Average \$3,000 \$22,000 in annual net cost savings (labor and water expenses included)
- Average 4-month ROI
- Typically spend \$500 on reusables
- Prevent 1,300 pounds of waste
- 100% of the time, restaurants see savings





### CALIFORNIA

- Oakland passed one of the strongest reusable foodware & plastic litter reduction ordinances in the Bay Area
- The Unity Council, owners of Oakland's historic
   Huarache Azteca restaurant, and ReThink Disposable
   partnered to target restaurants
- ReThink offered 5 restaurants an average of \$500 in incentive funding in the storied Fruitvale neighborhood to switch their dine-in foodware to reusable.





#### **HOUSE OF DIM SUM**

- \$429 upfront investment for reusable foodware
- \$33,561 in total annual net savings
- 2.2 million single-use items reduced per year
- 7.2 tons of yearly waste reduction
- ROI in 1.7 weeks






#### JEAN'S CAFE

After switching from 100% disposable foodware to 100% reusable foodware, Jean's Café is saving \$2,063 (accounts for increased labor and water expenses of \$12,000) and reducing 326,898 pieces of single-use disposable foodware (5,183 lbs!) annually.






- Launched Reusable Tray Pilot Across Club Level in 2022.










#### TSMC Washington







- TSMC Camas, WA campus made the switch to reusable cups, saving over 400,000 styrofoam cups from entering landfills annually.
- After introducing reusable cold cups for water in clean rooms, TSMC decided to make the push to also switch to reusable hot cups.


