


Attributes of Preemption

- Allows for higher level of government to limit or eliminate the regulatory authority of a lower level of government
 - → State halts local gov. from passing ordinances or repeals existing policies
- Proponents argue it stops regulatory patchworks
- Political tool against more progressive municipalities
- Not unique to environmental issues
- Containers ("auxilary containers")
 - → Bags, bottles, cups, boxes, etc.
 - → Plastic and other materials
 - → No prohibition, restriction, fee or tax

Example of preemption language - Indiana (<u>HB 1053</u>)

"Amends the home rule statute to prohibit a local government unit from: (1) regulating: (A) certain activities with respect to reusable or disposable auxiliary containers designed for one time use or for transporting merchandise or food from food or retail facilities (auxiliary containers); or (B) a manufacturer of, a distributor of, or a food or retail facility that sells, provides, or otherwise makes use of, auxiliary containers, in connection with certain activities involving auxiliary containers; or (2) imposing any prohibition, restriction, fee, or tax with respect to auxiliary containers or to a manufacturer of, a distributor."
