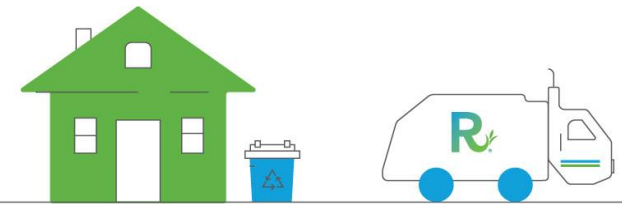

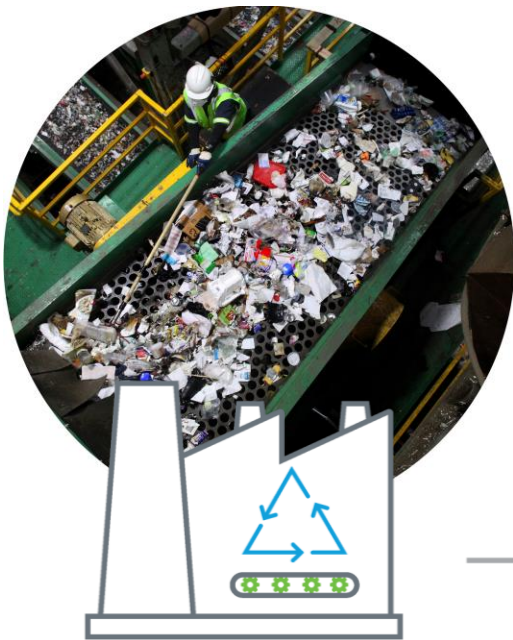

CALIFORNIA PLASTIC POLLUTION REDUCTION ACT

- Authorizes CalRecycle to ensure all plastic packaging is recyclable or compostable by 2030
- Reduces the amount of plastic packaging entering CA
- Polystyrene Food Container Ban
- Charges up to \$0.01 fee on all plastic packaging to pay for infrastructure, environmental restoration, local government litter programs



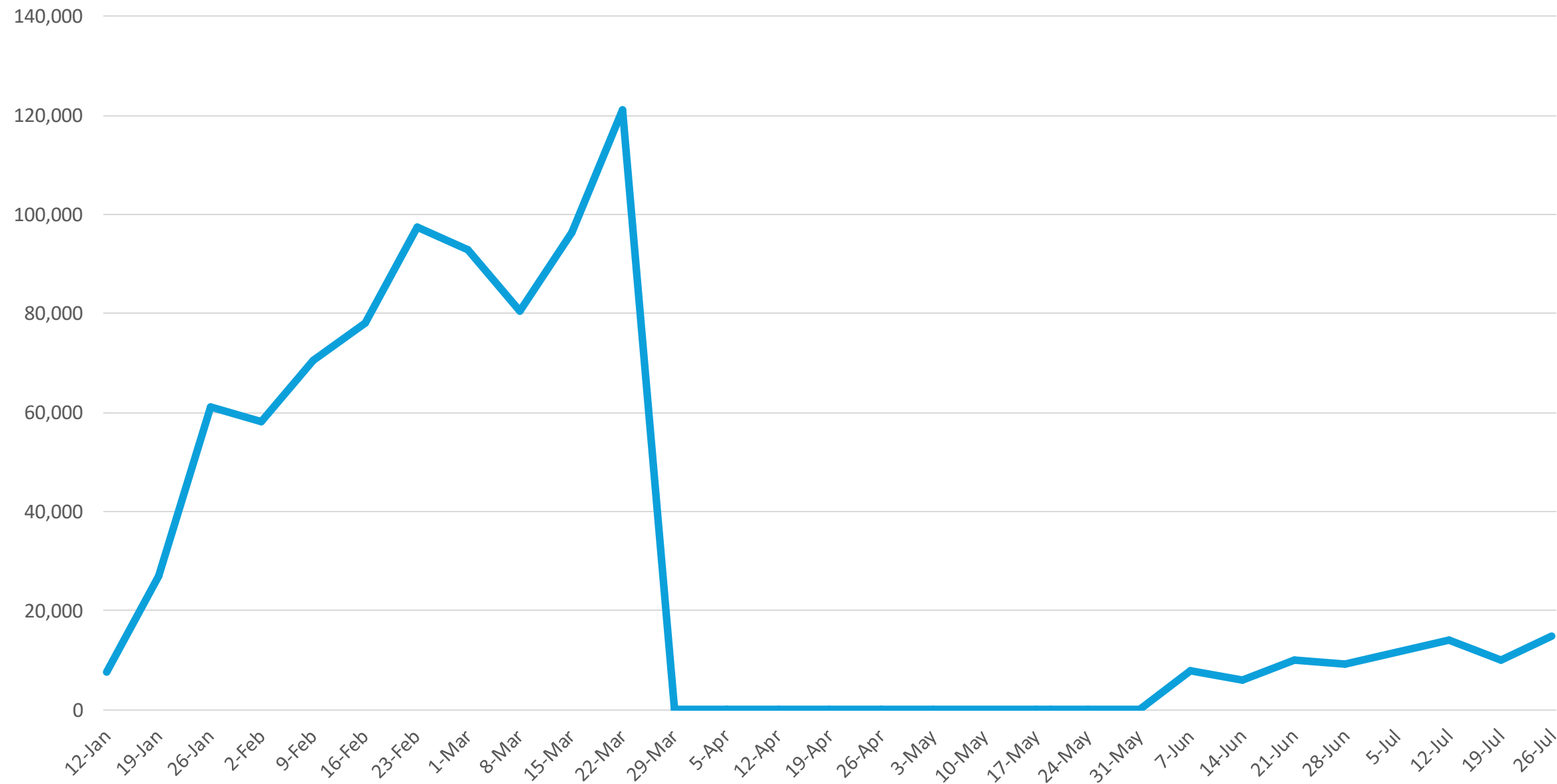
