- Dropped WTE plans
- 85% compliance rate in plastic ban
- 85 MRFs in 38 barangays
- Recognition for waste workers
- PAYT scheme for businesses

The city in Pampanga is the only LGU strictly adhering to the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act



San Fernando, Philippines



Waste Management in San Fernando (2011-2019, in tonnes)



• Recycling Rate: 81% (from 12% in 2012)

- 91% target by 2025
- 40.91 kg / y residual waste per capita
- Reduced waste collection spending to \$705,700 from \$1.4 million

TACLOBAN, Philippines



- Adopted Zero Waste in 2017
- Decentralized collection
- Waste collection went from 30% to 100% of all households without increased costs
- Barangay had history of flooding through unmanaged waste



Zero waste and inclusion



- High quality jobs
- Living wages and benefits
- Safe working environment
- Right to organize
- Allow and foster workers engagement in design of systems
- Address gender inequalities
- Understand and support specific needs. Buenos Aires City:
 - 3 child-care facilities for recyclers' children.
 - Open during the afternoon and at night, while their parents are working.
 - 200 children attend daily.

Global economic recession will hit hard worldwide. Zero waste programs may face funding limitations, but job creation funds could offer major new opportunities.

Zero waste creates jobs

- C40 estimates that the waste management sector has the potential to create 2.9 million jobs in its 97 member cities alone.
- An upcoming GAIA report on jobs impacts of zero waste finds that:
 - Reuse creates over 200 times as many jobs as landfills and incinerators.
 - Recycling creates around 70 times as many jobs as landfills and incinerators.
